Lalor Living and Learning Centre has been in existence for 27 years and provides a range of services in addition to accredited training, including occasional childcare, neighbourhood house and being a pre-accredited ACFE provider.

Lalor is a multi-cultural area with 10% of its population speaking Arabic, a strong Vietnamese community and people from India and Africa.

The focus of the Centre is on providing accredited training to meet the needs of the local community – those being to learn to speak and write English and to acquire skills to prepare for further study and/or employment i.e. general adult education.

Most of the staff are part-time and volunteers also assist with running the Centre.
