## Additional Course Information

### FEES & CHARGES

The Lalor Living & Learning Centre is a not-for-profit organisation so we keep our fees and charges as low as possible for fee for service students.

The Victorian Government provides subsidies for many of our courses: eligible students pay the Tuition Full Fee. Concessions may also be available - please contact our office to see if you qualify.

### REFUNDS

Refunds can only be given where the learner gives formal notice within 4 weeks of enrolment in the course, less administrative fee of 30% of all fees unless the course is cancelled by the Centre. For short courses no refunds apply after commencement of the course.

Referrals from agencies seeking to place funded clients in English or Literacy classes are welcome. Initial assessment of learner needs costs \$50, or \$70 if a written report is requested by the referring agency. In accordance with ACFE Guidelines about Fees, the concession fees in this brochure do not apply to students whose fees are met by Commonwealth Government agencies or as part of a Commonwealth program or initiative.

### MINIMUM CLASS NUMBERS

It should be noted that classes are subject to minimum enrolments, so some classes may be postponed or may not go ahead.
